Program Overview

Our dance program offers a variety of opportunities for students of all experience levels—from beginners to advanced performers and competitive dancers. Below is an overview of each option to help you find the best fit.

CHS Dance Team

- Performs at school events including halftime shows, rallies, dance concerts, and other special events
 - Meets during a scheduled period within the school day
 - Focuses on technique, performance, school spirit, and team collaboration

Dance 3 (Advanced)

- Advanced-level class for experienced dancers
 - Participates in dance concerts and 1-2 school rallies per year
 - Meets during a scheduled period within the school day

Dance 2 (Intermediate)

- Intermediate-level class for dancers building on foundational skills
 - Participates in dance concerts
 - Meets during a scheduled period within the school day

Dance 1 (Beginning)

- **No audition required**
 - Designed for students new to dance
 - Participates in dance concerts
 - Meets during a scheduled period within the school day

Competition Team *details subject to change

- Competes at regional and national dance competitions
 - Requires a high level of commitment and technical skill
 - Rehearses **2–3 days per week outside of school hours** in addition to performances
 - Ideal for dancers seeking a competitive and rigorous experience

- All dance classes (**Dance 1, Dance 2, Dance 3, and Dance Team**) fulfill either the **Physical Education (PE)** requirement **or** the **Fine Arts** requirement
 - Competition Team is an additional commitment and does not replace a class period

Dear Parents and Interested Students:

Thank you for your interest in applying for a position on the Calabasas High School Dance Team. Dance Team Tryouts will be held **Friday, May 15th 4-6:30pm** and **Saturday, May 16th 8am-1pm** in the Calabasas High School Dance Room. Prior to tryouts, it is important to review the many responsibilities and commitment involved in being a member of the team.

I. Commitment:

As a member of the CHS Dance Team, you will be required to attend all home varsity football and basketball games, both winter and spring dance concerts, all pep rallies and a few other school and community events. It is not yet determined which period Dance Team will be next year, but the team will meet during the school day and will only require additional hours outside of school for performances and occasional choreography rehearsals. Your attendance is vital towards allowing the team to perform their duties at school events to the fullest. Therefore, appointments, after school jobs, other extra-curricular activities, and social plans must be scheduled around all team practices and performances.

Team practices will begin on July 14th to prepare for camp, and mandatory rehearsals will be held the first few days before school. The CHS Dance Team will attend 1 local summer dance intensive where we will take classes from highly esteemed master teachers as well as learn dance routines to take home for school performances. The camp is a *very important* opportunity for the new team to get acquainted and build unity. Summer camp is not required but is **highly encouraged and a team expectation**. The camp will be held **July 18th – July 20th**.

Parent meetings are held once a month on Monday nights to discuss team events and fundraisers. Parent involvement is **essential** in helping make our program successful and families should be prepared to participate at team events including concerts and fundraisers.

II. Expenses:

The CHS dance program relies on outside contributions, donations and fundraising. To keep the program healthy, we run many fundraisers throughout the year and ask families to contribute to the team. Uniform items will be purchased at the first team meeting and summer camp fees will be collected. Loaner items are available upon request.

Estimated expenses:

Uniforms - \$500 (collected in June)

Camp - \$500 (includes 2 nights hotel; collected in June)

Guest Choreographers/Assistants/Additional Expenses – covered by fundraising and/or family contributions

III. Selection:

The number of team members is not predetermined, but approximately 25 dancers will be chosen for the team. They will be selected by a natural break in the scores. All applicants will audition before a panel of three independent judges. Team members will be placed on the team based on their dance ability, attitude, and judges' scores. Parents are encouraged to prepare their student for the possibility that he or she may not be chosen. Not all students who try out will make the team. All new and returning members are required to audition every year.

We are in search of those dancers who are **motivated**, hard-working, committed, confident, poised, genuine, **respectful** and have positive attitudes. We are looking for dancers who have **initiative** and **want to improve**. Once members have been selected to the team(s), they and their parents/guardians will sign a constitution outlining specific rules and commitments. If unwilling to adhere to any part of the constitution, membership will be denied.

COMPETITION TEAM

**Details subject to change*

This year, our Competition Team will run as an additional commitment/separate team for dancers seeking a competitive and rigorous experience. The team will be led by a separate head coach and dancers will prepare routines during after school practices. This team will represent our school at regional and national high school competitions.

After-school practice times will be set by the head coach and will depend on the availability of school facilities. This year, practices were held on Mondays from 3:30-6:30pm and Wednesdays from 5-8pm.

Competitions will take place on the weekends (mostly Saturdays) between December – March. The head coach will determine the details & competition dates, but the competition team will most likely compete at approximately 4-5 regionals and 1 National competition.

Choreography week is typically held the week before school starts, **August 10th – 14th** from **11am-4pm**. This week will help the competition team get a head start on competition routines and is typically MANDATORY for all team members. More info and details to come!

Outside technique classes are highly encouraged for all competition team members, with emphasis given to ballet. **The more technical the dancer is will directly affect how many competition routines he/she is in.**

Family contributions are on average between \$1,000 - \$3,000 per student over the course of the year. Costs increase with the participation level of each dancer.

2025 Competition Expenses: During the 2025-2026 school year, each team member was guaranteed to compete in 2 competition routines; one was required (free) and the other was optional. For all additional competition routines, the choreographer of each routine selected the dancers through an audition process. Each optional competition routine had its own required fee for registration and choreography. The cost was announced prior to the audition and a signed permission slip was required. Team members also had the option to audition for a solo. Each individual family is responsible for all costs associated with the solo.

The competition team's participation in scheduled competitions is completely dependent upon having the funds to provide these experiences. If the team is unable to raise sufficient funds to maintain its programs, it may need to scale back or cut these programs altogether for this school year.

May 14th– 16th Procedure

Tryout Procedure:

On Thursday, the **across-the-floor combinations** will be posted on the website for the dancers to learn and review at home. On Friday, the dancers will learn a **jazz routine** and a **contemporary routine** in person. The dancers will not be judged as they learn these routines. On Saturday, three independent adjudicators will be in attendance to judge the actual tryouts. The judges' scores will be based on technique, performance skills, knowledge of routines, and clean appearance. The judges will not know the routines the dancers have learned. Each dancer is to perform each combination to the best of his or her ability. A supplemental **solo video** will also be reviewed and considered in the dancers' scores.

***All dancers must have a 2.0 grade point average and good attendance to be eligible for dance team.**

*Dancers must stay until the end of the audition

*Dancers should wear tight fitted dance clothing. Hair must be pulled back in a ponytail or bun and tightly secured. Half soles are recommended. Athletic shoes are also recommended for potential outdoor practice.

Results will be posted on the CHS Dance Website. Upon posting results, a follow up email will be sent to all selected dancers and their parents with information about team meetings, upcoming dates etc.

Application Requirements:

A. ACADEMIC:

- Each applicant must have a 2.0 GPA or higher from the fall semester 2025.
 - Attach a copy of your grades from Aeries (fall semester)

Note: If a student's grades ever fall below 2.0, they will be put on probation and pulled from performances. If grades do not improve, they will be dismissed from the team.

B. ATTENDANCE:

- Each applicant must have good attendance (90% or higher with no more than 2 truants in one semester).
 - Attach a copy of your attendance for the '25-'26 school year (Aeries)
 - If a student does not have a 90% or higher, a *written explanation* must accompany the application along with a parent or guardian's signature and phone number. You will be denied the opportunity of auditioning if this requirement is not met.
 - A *current member's past attendance record* **will be** a consideration at tryouts. If a dancer is selected for team with poor attendance, they will be placed on probation until attendance is acceptable.

C. ATTITUDE:

- Each applicant needs to have 4 teacher recommendations.
- **New** dance team applicants may give the recommendations to the teachers of their choice. This can include one outside dance instructor. The others should be from school teachers.
- If you have Mrs. Furino for dance, you must include her for one of your recommendations.
- **Current** members who are re-auditioning must give their four recommendations to:
 - #1 Mrs. Furino
 - #2 Dance Teacher, Coach or School Teacher of their choice
 - #3 School Teacher of their choice
 - #4 School Teacher of their choice
- We are in search for those dancers who are **motivated**, hard-working, committed, confident, poised and respectful. We are looking for dancers who have **initiative** and **want** to improve.

D. SOLO ROUTINE - VIDEO SUBMISSION:

- Submit a video of a solo routine that is a minimum of 0:45 seconds and a maximum of 3 minutes. The solo can be in the style of jazz, lyrical, contemporary or hip hop. Choose a style that suits you best.
- Judges will be evaluating each dancer on technical proficiency, style and performance quality.
